Vortex Gymnastics Rules – Gymnasts training 1hr 15mins or more weekly

As your child progresses through Vortex Gymnastics, it is important to realise the level of commitment and attendance required.

This involves but is not limited to;

- Listening to and following instructions of coaches at all times
- Cooperating with other gymnasts in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner
- Attending classes in a punctual manner
- Maintaining excellent attendance at classes is compulsory
 - In the event that your child is sick, an email should be sent prior to the beginning of class
 - This includes attendance at weekly classes, extra training and summer classes (where appropriate)
- Practice necessary stretches as recommended by coaches during their own time
- Attire
 - o In the interest of safety, gymnasts training for 1hr 15mins or more weekly must wear a leotard to every training session.
 - Gymnasts do not have to wear a Vortex leotard for weekly training, however any gymnast representing Vortex Gymnastics at National events must wear the Vortex leotard and tracksuit to these events - available at https://www.vortexgymnastics.com/shop
 - If a child attends training without suitable clothing, they will not be allowed to participate in the class activities. They will be given a list of conditioning exercises to complete instead during class time.
 - o As per general rules, no jewellery of any description should be worn
